NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 4 of the MBM University, Jodhpur Act, 2021 and in consultation with the MBM University, Jodhpur, the State Government hereby enumerates the Government Engineering College, Barmer as a Constituent College of the MBM University, Jodhpur hereinafter referred to as MBMU, with immediate effect, on the following terms and conditions, namely:-

1. Only Regularly recruited and permanent employee drawing monthly salary is to be absorbed provided he possess the requisite qualification prescribed for the post by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE);
2. Equation of posts with the post of MBMU is to be made;
3. Such of the staff who are eligible for absorption if willing will be absorbed by screening;
4. The absorption will be subject to availability of post and vacancy;
5. If the equated post is not available absorption can be on the lower post. Similarly, if the concerned incumbent does not possess the requisite qualification of the post, he may be absorbed on lower post;
6. The screening will be made by the committee mentioned in the clause 16;
7. The candidate for absorption is not less than 21 years of age and not more than the age of 60 years;
8. The employee must be physically fit and does not suffer from any disqualifications for recruitment as per rules for the post concerned;
9. The persons so selected shall be considered as fresh recruits;
10. The appointment shall be in the same capacity of substantive or temporary;
11. The condition of probation and confirmation shall be deemed to have been waived in the case of substantive officials;
12. The seniority of the persons absorbed shall rank enblock junior to persons appointed by direct recruitment or by promotion;
13. The inter-se-seniority of such absorbed persons will be fixed according to the date of appointment in the Engineering College;

14. The service rendered by the employees of Engineering College on an equated post shall be counted as experience of service required for promotion or direct recruitment, as the case may be;
15. All the employees who are regularly selected may be allowed to be screened by the committee. Employees of guest faculty will not be eligible for absorption/appointment in the constituent college;
16. Constitution of the screening committee shall be as under:-

Note: The arrangement, expenses of the meetings etc. shall be made and the records should be kept by member secretary of the committee.

17. In cases where faculty of Engineering College is transferred to other station the concerned employee if willing for absorption will be absorbed at the transferred place of the faculty if he is not willing services will be retrenched;
18. The land, buildings, laboratories, equipments, books and any other properties of such college shall then vest in the MBMU and the officers, teachers and employees of such college after being found suitable through screening and on fulfilling such terms and conditions mentioned in this notification, shall be deemed to be the officers, teachers or as the case may be employees of the MBMU;
19. These employees are already getting Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) as per AICTE and selection scale/ACP as per State Rules, Hence, the pay drawn by these employees in these scale have to be protected. However, entry level post will be created by the FD (Exp.) and not in senior and selection scale of AICTE and selection/ACP of the State pay scale;

20. No arrear on any account shall be paid by the State Government for the period prior to the date of their absorption;
21. Since the respective Engineering College is being made constituent college of the MBMU with the employees and assets hence, the carry forwarded of the balance of PL have to be allowed;
22. The employee shall be made member of NPS scheme except those employee who are member of CPF may continued to existing CPF;
23. The period of service rendered in the Engineering College may also be counted for grant of gratuity at the time of final retirement from the MBMU; and
24. Each absorbed employee shall be required to execute an undertaking that he/she voluntarily accepts all the terms and conditions on absorption.
